Certainly, Adelphi, like most organizations, had a tough year last year to navigate through given Fortunately for us, we were Covid. able to move through our fiscal 2020 year with a very small deficit, \$280,000. Going forward, you know, we were able to take a number of actions in order to maintain strong financial viability. We've done a lot in terms of working with our personnel and our staff around different opportunities to reduce cost. Also, we did things around early retirement programs, try to control hiring and discretionary spending. I think from a financial perspective, the institution is in a very good position. We were able to finish the year, as I mentioned, with, more or less, a break even result. Our enrollment has been projected to be much stronger than

think we've also had the benefit
over the last year and again for
this year of receiving (inaudible)

I believe that as we get ready for our spring term, we're seeing that the enrollment projections are holding very strong and we should be in a good position to finish out the year in a very positive way. I do thank you for the time this morning.
