

BIO FOR JERRY KORNBLOTH

Jerry Kornbluth earned his B.S. Degree in Statistics from Bowling Green State University and his M.B.A and Ph.D from Hofstra University. He taught Math and Statistics for 35 years at Nassau Community College. Dr. Kornbluth achieved the rank of Full Professor in 1979. Dr. Kornbluth was also an Adjunct Professor at La Guardia CC and Queensborough CC for 32 years. He has also worked with school districts throughout New York City and Long Island, as well as with Federal Agencies as a statistical research consultant. Dr. Kornbluth was also Vice-President of Academic Affairs for 5 years at Interboro Institute, a for-profit 2-year college with campuses in Manhattan, Queens and Yonkers. Dr. Kornbluth returned to Nassau Community College as the Interim Dean of Nursing and Allied Health in the spring of 2013. Since the fall of 2013, Dr. Kornbluth has been the Dean for Professional Studies.

Jerry has been an active member of the Freeport-Roosevelt Branch of the NAACP. He is also on the Board of Directors of the Hispanic Brotherhood of Rockville Centre. Jerry is also member of the Executive Board of the Long Island Hospitality and Leisure Association (LIHLA), as well as an Executive Board Member of the NEST at NCC. The NEST is a Food Pantry that has served students, staff and faculty at NCC since 2014. Dr. Kornbluth was a member of the Board of Trustees at the New York Career Institute, a for-profit 2-year college located in New York City from 2009-2016. Jerry is also a Member of the LIPA/PSEG Community Advisory Board. It must also be noted that Dr. Kornbluth co-published 5 textbooks in Mathematics and Statistics for Cengage Publishing Company.
